CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES	<p>Section 1: Manildra School Championship 4pm Friday 11 February 2022</p> <p>Section 2: Open Steer Challenge 4pm Thursday 14 April, 2022</p> <p>Section 3: Commercial Non-led Steer Challenge 4pm Friday 22 April, 2022</p>
ENTRY RESTRICTIONS	Maximum two (2) entries per school for the Manildra School Championship (<i>Section 1 see Regulations</i>). No restrictions for Sections 2 or 3.
ENTRY FEES	Entry Fee for School Steer Spectacular \$130 per steer (no GST) and non-refundable. Entries in Section 1 may also be entered in Section 2 for an additional \$100.
BREEDS	Entries for the School Steer Spectacular are open to all commercial beef breeds and their crosses (no dairy breeds or their crosses)
BUMP-IN	Sections 1 & 2: Cattle MUST be at Nowra Showground before 9am Tuesday 3 May 2022. Section 3: Cattle MUST be at Nowra Showground before 9am Wednesday 4 May.
TIMETABLE	Day 1: Tuesday 3 May – Workshops and skills development day Day 2: Wednesday 4 May - Competition day including live steer judging and parading
CARCASS JUDGING	Saturday 7 May 2022.
SALE OF CARCASSES	Carcasses will be sold over-the-hooks with payments based on carcass score. Carcasses will be scored for compliance with market specification, retail meat yield and eating quality as per judging criteria (<i>See Regulations</i>).
ENTRY FORMS	Entry Forms must be received by the SCB School Steer Spectacular by the closing dates listed above. (<i>See southcoastbeef.asn.au for Entry Forms</i>).
VENDOR DECLARATIONS	<p><i>All steers entered in the Spectacular:</i></p> <p>On arrival at the Nowra Showground exhibitors must present two completed copies of the: NATIONAL VENDOR DECLARATION (NVD) and Owner Advice Form</p> <p>Failure to present the NVD may result in disqualification of the Exhibit(s)</p> <p><i>Cattle required for parading competition only and to be returned to the property MUST be accompanied by a separate NVD.</i></p>
REPRESENTING YOUR SCHOOL	Students, schools, entrants and steers must be prepared and attend to competitions in timely manner and in attire that meets industry standards. School representatives, students and entrants will at all times during the Spectacular, conduct themselves in a respectful and courteous manner.
SOCIAL MEDIA	All entrants are encouraged to post images and information about the Spectacular on social media eg FB, newsletters etc. to inform your community and others of the Spectacular. Ideally schools are encouraged to appoint a coordinator or representative.
PARADING COMPETITION	Schools are encouraged to bring extra cattle to Nowra Showground for participation in the parading competitions. WARNING: Any female cattle should not be pregnant as there is no requirement for cattle to be tested for Pestivirus.
