
HOW TO PARTICIPATE IN THE 2024 SCHOOL STEER SPECTACULARTM






Complete your Expression of Interest form, available on the SCB website to recieve your email invitation to join the 2024 School Steer Spectaluar Google Classroom. Due 10th November 2023.



If your school does not have a PIC, you will need to apply through your Local Land Services.


If your school is not already LPA accredited, you will need apply for accreditation through Meat and Livestock Australia.

Once you have a PIC and LPA accreditation you can create an NLIS account.



Complete the Request for Assistance form (01) if you need steers and/or help with infrastructure to house and train your cattle. A representative from SCB will be in contact to follow up your request.

Due 1st December 2023.



Log onto Google Classroom to complete the digital Agreement Form (O2). Steers will not be delivered without a completed agreement. This must be completed before steers will be delivered.

Due 9th February 2024.






Complete the Request for DDG form (03) on Google Classroom. You will need to pick up the DDG on one of the designated pick-up dates from Bomaderry, NSW, just before your steers arrive at your school early term 1, 2024.

You will receive your steers at your school early term 1, 2024. You will need to check the NLIS tag number. The breeder will have supplied you with an NVD to double-check that the numbers correspond.



Transfer the steers onto your school PIC using their NLIS tag number through your NLIS account.

Complete and submit Report 1 (Form 04) detailing your school's infrastructure for housing and training your steers.

Due 1st March 2024.





Begin training your steers for show. SCB is able to assist you on how to do this and resources is available through the Google Classrom.






Complete the online Registration and Entry Form (05) for the 2024 Spectacular. SCB will issue an invoice for payment.

Due 22 March 2024.



Pay SCB invoice for entry fees via the SCB website.






Complete and submit Report 2 (Form 06) detailing your steers training progress, weight gain so far, and any medical applications.

Due 5th April 2024.





Complete and submit the Risk Acknowledgement Waiver (07).

Due 3rd May 2024.



Complete an NVD (transfer PIC details will be on the Google Classroom). All cattle brought to the Spectacular must be accompanied by a hard copy of the NVD if they are not returning to your school. Any cattle required for parading competition only that will be returning to the exhibitors property must be accompanied by a Transport and Stock Statement (TSS). Information on how to complete an NVD and a TSS is available on the Google Classroom.

Due 7th May 2024.



Complete and submit the Owner Advice Form (08) and the final report (09). A hard copy of the report is required for presentation markers at the event.

Due 6th May 2024.



Transport your steers to Nowra Showground with a hard copy of your NVD. See the Show Schedule for what's going on over the two days and enjoy the Show!
